Smith's squad will train under the new coach from the 2nd - 11th February 2013 and will also play three friendly games vs. Spain during the training camp. Included in the Irish squad are 3 St Andrew's past pupils, congratulations to **Niamh Atcheler** (2010), Gillian Pinder (2011) and Chloe Watkins (2010) on their selection and also to **Nikki Symmons** who coaches hockey in the College.
