Dear Parents/Guardians,

As you are aware, the College offers supervised evening study for pupils in 3rd, 5th and 6th Year. The third opportunity to sign up for these sessions is being made available to students for the period up to the Christmas break.

**This is an online application process which will be open from Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December to Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December. Students will go to the following address**

**Students will require their school email and password to complete the application**

**Here they will register using their SAC email. They will then be required to sign into their SAC email (found on [www.sac.ie](http://www.sac.ie) login button beside menu) where they will have received a mail which has the application attached. Students will not be able to sign up after Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December.**

**Cheques are still to be handed in to reception no later than Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December marked for evening study and with the students name and form written clearly.**

**Study will start back on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January**

Supervised study is a very effective means of providing pupils with an environment that is conducive to the productive reinforcement of learning. Participants are at all times supervised by a senior member of staff who can offer advice and support if required. Unfortunately numbers of places are limited and are offered on a strictly first come first served basis.

In order to facilitate the successful running of this years programme of supervised study pupils must be aware that commitment to attend all signed up sessions is expected. The following should also be noted:

- Pupils must familiarise themselves with the timetable of any activities they are involved in to avoid clashes in nights that they are considering signing up for.
- If a pupil misses a session a refund or credit will not be given (exceptional circumstances may be considered).
- Repeated unexplained absence will lead to the forfeiture of a place, as will failure to comply with the instructions laid down by the supervisors.
- The transfer of study sessions to different days is not permitted.

**There are 8 sessions of study per week divided into the following categories:**
