Andrew began his music education playing piano and trumpet at the age of 4 studying at the College of Music Dublin. During his early years he was a prizewinner at Feis Mathieu Dublin and at Feis Ceoil, winning first prize for trumpet. Established as one of Ireland's foremost bassists, Andrew has a busy performance schedule and has made numerous appearances on radio and television, as well as performing all over Ireland and the U.K..
