#### Transition Year Portfolio interviews:

The portfolio interviews take place twice during the year and are an important component of the year's overall award criteria. Each interview is conducted with the students' form teacher and lasts approximately 10 minutes.

There is extensive documentation outlining what is expected in terms of support material, preparation and presentation to achieve a top grade in the interview.

The aim of the interview process is to encourage students to fully participate in, and then to present and reflect upon their level of involvement and effort in the Transition Year Programme.

All aspects of the students TY experience should be explored from academic core subjects to timetabled modules, but also extra-curricular activities; sporting and creative, group and individual work, school supported and outside school organized.

Furthermore, the interview process aims to help students understand, experience and learn from the process of a meaningful interview and gain life skills to assist them into the future.

Examples of Core documentation might include:

Homework / tests / vocab sheets etc

Examples of option module or Friday afternoon activities might be: Photos / written reports / reflections

Evidence of extra curricular activities could be wide ranging but must be in document format to show preparation for the interview (simply talking about a topic will not earn you a high grade)

Extra curricular activities should be a combination of schoolorganised and externally-organised activities

Social Volunteering is strongly encouraged
