

Data Protection

DANISH

The State Examinations Commission (SEC) is a registered data controller with the Office of the Data Protection Commissioner. Other than this your personal information will not be disclosed to any external third party without your consent, except where necessary to comply with statutory requirements or where an organisation is acting as an agent of the SEC. You have the right to request a copy of your personal information as well as, in certain circumstances, the right to erase or correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal information held by the SEC. By signing this form you are giving your consent to the SEC to process your personal information as required for the purposes of the administration of your participation in the State Certificate Examinations.



Garda Vetting

Work Experience and garda vetting

- 2 blocks of work experience on the calendar
- lots of individual (worthwhile) opportunities spread throughout the year

Garda Vetting

- Only relevant when you turn 16
- Usually only relevant if employer requests it
- Must be applied for through school
- Might take a long time to process (can be up to 8 weeks)
- Forms available at reception will require passport

Parental feedback

Get involved. Play Sport. Be prepared for friendships to change/move and be open to forming friendships with others.

Try something new and/or something they have always wanted to do - Get involved - Say Yes to everything! - It's a short year

Give your son/daughter more responsibility; they should check notice boards, know when events are happening, be in the right uniform etc

Organise work experience early

Step back and allow your child to be more independent and sociable
